## Mumbai Climate Action Plan

The Mumbai Climate Action Plan (MCAP), published in March 2022, provides a roadmap for Mumbai to achieve the goals of the Paris Agreement by reducing greenhouse gas emissions and integrating climate adaptation strategies to manage increasing climate risks, leading up to 2050, which is the target year for the plan.

The main objective of the plan is to create a comprehensive strategy to tackle the challenges of climate change in Mumbai by adopting inclusive and robust mitigation and adaptation strategies. Framed as a policy document, the MCAP uses evidence-based approach to planning and mobilizing resources for implementing action tracks and strategic projects. The MCAP processes are closely aligned with the Development Plan for Greater Mumbai 2014-34 (DP 2034) and various sector-specific plans and policies to leverage existing institutional capital towards a unified goal.

The MCAP outlines climate risks for Mumbai, provides detailed city and emissions profiles, assesses vulnerabilities, predicts future emission trends, and suggests ways to reduce emissions and increase resilience. It takes a comprehensive approach to ensure Mumbai is prepared to tackle climate change challenges and build resilience through strategic, datadriven, and scientifically grounded actions.
