Terms and conditions for the post of Data managers to be appointed on contract basis

1. Candidate shall bear the prescribed qualification for selected posts.
2. Candidate appointed on contract basis will not be able to claim for regular service of the Corporation.
3. The candidate, if selected will have to submit contract agreement on bond paper of Rs. 100/- to Rs. 500/- in BMC format.
4. Candidate will not be given any other kind of allowance except applicable fix remuneration.
5. The contract is for specific period of 6 months and the post will expire after the expiry of the term.
6. No administrative or financial rights of MCGM will be granted to selected candidates during the contract period.
7. If the work of a contractual candidates is unsatisfactory during the contract period, the appointment of such candidates on contract basis will be terminated without any prior notice.
8. Candidates have to ensure that they fulfill all the qualifications and conditions of the post applied for. Candidates will be disqualified at any point of time if they are found to be not fulfilling the prescribed qualifications and conditions.
9. Correspondence address should be clear and complete.
10. Selected candidates should be present for further selection procedure with Certificates of Educational Qualification, Professional Qualifications, Marksheets, Certificate of Experience. (original copies and attested Xerox copies.)
11. Candidates have to be present at the place of selection at their own cost.
12. Candidates will be disqualified if they are found to have submitted incorrect information / certificates / documents or withheld any information at any time after the commencement of selection process or appointment. Also, if the appointment is made, their contract appointment will be terminated without any prior notice.
13. The Mumbai Municipal Corporation (Services) Rules 1989 and the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation Services (Conduct) Rules 1999 will not be applicable to the selected candidate after appointment.
14. The administration reserves the right to terminate the services of candidates appointed on contract basis without prior notice.
15. As the service of the candidates working during the contract period is temporary, their service will not be considered for seniority or the service will not be given priority for seniority.
16. Only online applications are considered valid and those received by post at the concerned office and other places will not be considered valid. Also note that BMC has not given the right to any person or any other organization to sell or accept applications.
17. If a candidate attempts to exert pressure at any stage of recruitment or is found to have resorted to improper means or to arrange for imposters, he will be disqualified from the selection.
18. Candidates are been advised to beware of the promise of getting a job through a person who pretends to be a mediator for BMC.
19. The Mumbai Municipal Commissioner has the power to stop the contractual recruitment process at any time or at any stage for administrative or other reasons.

20. Candidates will be considered on merit but final decision will be taken by the administration.
21. If a candidate submits any documents after the prescribed time, those documents will not be considered and his application will be deemed ineligible.
