

## **MANUAL – 12**

### **The Manner of Execution of subsidy programmes.**

This hospital is a Municipal General Hospital and so all facilities are available free of charge or with token fees as prescribed by the authorities, for all sections of the society.

#### **OPD services:**

1. OPD case papers (subsidised) at Rs. 10 for 14 days anywhere in municipal institutions.
2. Routine laboratory investigations done free of cost.
3. ECG at subsidised rate of Rs: 20
4. X-ray at subsidised rate of Rs: 30 per film
5. USG for Rs: 100
6. All medicines at free of cost.

#### **Indoor Services:**

1. Indoor admissions free of cost
2. Routine lab investigations at free of cost.
3. ECG, X-ray, USG at subsidised rate as above.
4. Medicines free of cost.
5. Diet, Tea, Breakfast, etc. free of cost
6. Operation charges at subsidised rate.

In case of very poor patients, Poor Box Charity Funds are utilized for providing the services. On prescribed form, the patient attending the hospital, makes an

application for the help, which, after interview with the patient and/or his/her relatives and if found needy, is sanctioned by Sr.MO/CMO.

Objective of the program is to make healthcare services affordable to all strata of population.

Physical and financial targets of the programs.

Municipal Employees/Relatives (dependents)/Municipal School Children as per BMC norms

Janani Suraksha Yojana provides financial help to the pregnant mothers above 19 years of age and for the first two deliveries, who are below poverty line, SC, ST in the form of Rs: 600/-
