## **Technical Specification**

1. The work of collection and transportation of mixed material Waste shall be carried out by deploying the following machinery and vehicles:
  - a. Excavator Loader-Clam shovel 6:1 Bucket Loader conforming to Escort JCB-3D, LT-580-2 Model or equivalent/ higher model.
  - b. Dumpers (minimum 16 Cu. Mtr volumetric capacity) without labours.
  - c. All vehicles/Machinery shall fulfill the RTO requirements.
2. The Dumper to be used for transportation for mixed material Waste shall be of hydraulic tipping type with minimum 16 Cu. Mtr volumetric capacity. The Dumper shall be complete with rear flap (Phalka) & tarpaulin covers. The Dumper shall be of sturdy construction, aesthetically painted & in mechanically sound condition.
3. The vehicles/equipments shall be road worthy vehicles as approved by R.T.O. conforming to rules & regulations prescribed in this respect from time to time. The vehicles/equipments shall be in good condition so as to have service reliability. The vehicles/equipments shall be registered with R.T.O.
4. The contractor shall be responsible for supply of CNG, diesel, driver/cleaner, oils etc. & any other material required for operation & running of vehicles and machines, at their own cost.
5. The Dumpers shall be painted. The shade of colour & other lettering shall be got approved from the concern A.E.(S.W.M) ward. The vehicles/equipments shall be painted every year in order that the vehicles/equipments shall look good with slogans as suggested by ward.
6. The contractor shall submit all relevant documents of Excavator-cum-Loader, Dumpers & Tempos along with loading body measurements of Dumpers before execution of work, in the office of A.E.(SWM) of respective wards, for checking & confirmation purpose and record of same shall be maintained.
7. If the contractor desires to change the machinery/vehicles during the contract period, they shall submit the relevant documents of new vehicles in the office of A.E.(SWM) of respective ward then only deploy the said vehicle/ vehicles.
8. The contractor shall be responsible for all the required material, articles, manpower, supervisory and managerial arrangement for carrying out the work apart from the machinery & dumpers.

**Schedule of penalties:-**

1	Penalty if the vehicle does not unload at appropriate place & as per instructions at the dumping ground / disposal site.	:	Rs.1000/- per trip per vehicle.
2	Penalty for Non-reporting of vehicle after 4 hours of breakdown of vehicle before starting of work & failure of contractor to make alternate arrangements.	:	Rs.1000/- per trip per vehicle.
3	Penalty for breakdown after starting the work & failure of contractor to make alternate arrangement within 3 hours for transferring the debris from the breakdown vehicle, the Corporation requires making necessary arrangement.	:	Rs.1500/- per vehicle per shift +cost of alternate arrangement at risk & cost of the bidder + 15 % supervision charges.
4	Penalty for Non-reporting of vehicle within 1 hour from intended time.	:	Rs.200/- per vehicle per shift.
5	Penalty for short supply of vehicles indented for the day within the specified quota.	:	Rs.2000/- per vehicle.
6	Penalty for not supplying the JCB as per indented.	:	Rs.5000/- per JCB.
7	Penalty for failure to attend any site.	:	Rs.2000/- per Site..
8	Penalty for failure to provide "On Municipal Duty" board on the vehicle.	:	Rs.200/- per vehicle per shift.
9	Penalty for failure to keep the vehicles well painted. it shall be again painted once in a year (i.e. 12 months) during the entire contract period.	:	Rs.500/- per vehicle per day till vehicles are painted.
10	Lump sum penalty for not starting the work after completion of mobilization period of 7 days	:	Rs.10,000/- per day

14	Penalty for not having rear flap (Phalka) in the perfect condition, which results spilling of debris on road.	:	Rs. 500/- per such dumper trip.
15	Penalty for damaging collection spots / roads/ Municipal property by JCB.	:	Rs.500/- per spot
16	Penalty for not clearing backlog within 24 hrs.	:	Rs. 500/- per M.T.
