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SECTION – I - PREAMBLE

1. INTRODUCTION–

Data provided in “**Volume-I**” is tentative. It is provided in two parts- The scope of work and design Criteria. Bidder is advised to ascertain accurate facts and detail from his own due diligence. Obligatory requirements given shall be followed scrupulously in design of the Network Arch Bridge, Viaduct and Solid approach. The modality of preparation and submission of design and drawings by the Contractor’s and approval by the Engineer is given in volume I.

The Price Schedules shall be read in conjunction with the “Instructions to Bidders”, “General Conditions”, “Particular Conditions”, “Employer’s Requirement”, “Technical Specifications”, and “Drawings”.

2. CONTRACTOR’S GENERAL ENGINEERING, DESIGN & PROCUREMENT OBLIGATIONS–

The Contractor’s shall be solely responsible for the Engineering, Procurement and Design of the work and for the adequacy thereof. Contractor’s responsibility in any way shall neither be diminished, nor shall the Contractor’s design approach be limited by the Employer’s acceptance to engineering standards and design specification, or by Employer’s approval, suggestions or recommendations on any aspect of engineering or design. The work shall be carried out as per the design prepared by the bidder and approved by the employer, the work shall also include shifting of utilities, removal of electric poles, cutting and removal of trees with prior permission of client, the detail of which are given separately. GAD preparation by the MCGM (as enclosed in Vol I) through their consultant is intended to give a fair idea of scope of work. However, it should be clearly understood that

- a. The Bidder is required to give **lump sum offer based on his own design for the entire scope of work**. The bidder shall quote lump sum in INR for the entire project including Design, Construction and commissioning as per scope of work.
- b. The Bidder is deemed to have understood and visualized the nature and type of work contemplated with due consideration of qualitative and quantitative requirements of the job consistent with the site conditions, complexities of work which have a bearing on the actual execution/construction etc. While doing so, however, he must strictly adhere to salient parameters and obligatory requirement which are indicated in volume-I.
- c. The cost shall cover all the items of the work as detailed in the “Work Requirement” contained in Volume I of the Bid document as well as conforming to all specifications and stipulations laid down in the Bid Document including all addenda/corrigena thereof till the date of submission of Bids.
- d. The lump sum cost shall be inclusive of all costs on Design & Drawings including approvals to same, Geotechnical investigation & Reports, Detailed Survey, Site Facilities, Approval for necessary navigational clearances, NOC from various authorities, including manpower

deployment Construction Equipment, Plants, Instruments, Labor, Supervision, Materials, Erection, Testing, Maintenance during execution till completion as required, Temporary Works, Site Access, Safety, Security, Defect Rectification, Insurance, Profit, duties, and other applicable taxes, Levies, Royalties as per applicable law together with all general risks, liabilities and obligations set out or implied in the contract. The fees for proof checking consultant appointed by MCGM shall be borne by MCGM. The statutory fees to be paid to various authorities such as Forest, Collector, MCZMA, SEIA, etc. for availing the various permissions / NOCs will be borne by MCGM.

GENERAL RULES AND DIRECTIONS FOR THE GUIDANCE OF CONTRACTOR'S:-

- 1 All works proposed to be executed by contract shall be notified in the form of invitation to tender pasted on a board hung up in the office of the Chief Engineer, MCGM and signed by the Chief Engineer, MCGM. This form will state the work to be carried out as well as the date for submitting and opening tenders, and the time allowed for carrying out the work, also the amount of earnest money to be deposited with the tender, and the amount of the security deposit to be deposited by the successful tenderer and the percentage, if any, to be deducted from bills. Where the works are proposed to be executed according to the specifications recommended by a Contractor's and approved by a competent authority on behalf of the Corporation, such specifications with designs and drawings shall form part of the accepted tender.
2. In the event of the tender being submitted by a firm, it must be signed by each partner thereof, and in the event of the absence of any partner, it shall be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to do so.
 2. (A)
 - i) The Contractor's shall pay along with the tender the sum of **Rs. 2,38,01,400/- (Rupees Two Crore Thirty Eight Lakhs One Thousand Four Hundred Only)**, as and by way of earnest money. The Contractor's shall pay the said amount by gateway system with the tender. The said amount of earnest money shall not carry any interest whatsoever.
 - ii) in the event of his tender being accepted, subject to the provisions of sub-clause (iii) below, the said amount of earnest money shall be appropriated towards the amount of security deposit payable by him under conditions General Conditions of Contract.
 - iii) If, after last date of submission the tender, the Contractor withdraws his offer, or



modifies the same, or if after the acceptance of his tender the Contractor's fails or neglects to furnish the balance of security deposit, without prejudice to any other rights and powers of the Corporation, hereunder, or in law, Corporation shall be entitled to forfeit the full amount of the earnest money deposited by him.

- iv) in the event of his tender not being accepted, the amount of earnest money deposited by the Contractor's shall unless it is prior thereto forfeited under the provisions of sub-clause (iii) above, be refunded to him on his passing receipt, therefore.
3. Receipts for payments made on account of any work, when executed by a firm, should also be signed by all the partners except where the Contractors are described in their tender as firm, in which case the receipt shall be signed in the name of the firm, by one of the partners, or by some other person having authority to give effectual receipts for the firm.
4. The Chief Engineer or his duly authorized representative shall open tenders in the presence of Contractor's who have submitted tender's or their representatives who may be present at the time, and he will enter the amounts of the several tenders in a comparative statement' in a suitable form. In the event of a tender being accepted, (the Contractor's shall for the purpose of identification, sign copies of the specifications and other documents mentioned in rule 1. In the event of tender being rejected, EMD amount submitted will be refunded electronically.
5. The officer competent to dispose-of the tenders shall have the right of rejecting all or any of the tenders.
6. No receipt for any payment alleged to have been made by a Contractor's in regard to any matter relating to this tender or the contract shall be valid & binding on MCGM unless it is signed by the Chief Engineer or other appropriate Officer of MCGM
7. All work shall be measured net by standard measure and according to the rules and customs of the MCGM and without reference to any local custom.
9. Under no circumstances shall any Contractor's be entitled to claim enhanced rates for items in this contract.
10. The measurements of work will be taken by methods in use in the MCGM. The Chief Engineer's decision as to what is the usual method in Department will be final.
11. The tendering Contractor's shall furnish a declaration along with the tender showing all works for which he has already entered contract and the value of the work that remains to be executed in each case on the date of submitting the tender.
12. Every tenderer shall furnish along with the tender, information regarding the Income-Tax Circle or



ward of the district in which he is assessed to income-tax, the reference to the number of the assessment and the assessment year, and a valid Income Tax Clearance Certificate.

13. In view of the difficult position regarding the availability of foreign exchange, no foreign exchange would be released by the MCGM for the purchase of plant and machinery required for the execution of the work contracted for.
14. The Contractor shall also give a list of machinery, hired machinery in their possession and which they propose to use on the work in the prescribed form.
15. Every un-registered Contractor should furnish along with tender a statement showing previous experience and technical staff employed by him, in the prescribed form.
16. Successful tenderer will have to produce to the satisfaction of the accepting authority a valid and current license issued in his favor under the provision of Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition Act 1973) before starting work, failing which acceptance of the tender will be liable for withdrawal and earnest money will be forfeited by Corporation.
19. The Contractor's shall comply with the provision of the Apprentices Act 1961 and the rules and orders issued there under from time to time. If he fails to do so, his failure will be breach of the contract and the Chief Engineer, may in his discretion cancel the contract. The Contractor's shall also be liable for liability arising on account of any violation by him of the provisions of the Act.
